



Becoming a NRP
Instructor

Eligibility:

- MDs, RNs, RMs, RRTs; also other health professionals approved by their Provincial / NRP Committee
- Participants should have relevant experience in neonatal care
- Participants should have a Letter of Support from the sponsoring institution that normally provides NRP courses. (A sample letter of support is appended).

Pre-requisites:

- Successful completion of an NRP
 Provider Course with all lessons (1-9) within 24 months prior to the Instructor Course; and
- Knowledge of current updates, Canadian recommendations, and changes.

Post-requisites:

- New instructors will be required to provide their online exam certificate with their Instructor
 Registration Form, even if it has been completed in the previous 12 months.
- A New Instructor Registration Form has been attached with this brochure. The renewal period for NRP Instructors changed on Jan. 1, 2013 from a 2-year period to a 3-year period. Fees can be found on the CPS website.
