

## PPE Standard

- Staff in OB Triage caring for non COVID/non-suspect COVID patients to wear
  - Level II with eye protection
  - Level I (yellow mask with ear loops) with face shield at all times
- Staff assigned to provide care for COVID/suspect COVID patients to wear
  - Level 2 (Blue mask) or level I (yellow mask with ear loops) with face shield
  - Isolation gown (reusable or disposable)
  - Gloves
  - Eye protection (goggles or face shield)
- Staff in any area present during AGMP's to wear
  - N95
  - Isolation gown (reusable or disposable)
  - Gloves
  - Eye protection (goggles or face shield)

**New change as of Mar 31, 2020: 2 masks(shields)/shift/provider for non-covid care**

**OR PPE (*Note: No visitors in the OR. Essential personnel only for the preservation of PPE*)**

### Epidural OR

- Level 2 (Blue mask) or level I (yellow mask with ear loops) with face shield
- Isolation gown (reusable or disposable)
- Gloves
- Eye protection (goggles or face shield)
- *Where possible where full face shield to maintain conservation of masks*
- *If converting step out and don airborne precaution*

### Vaginal Delivery in OR

- Level 2 (Blue mask) or level I (yellow mask with ear loops) with face shield
- Isolation gown (reusable or disposable)
- Gloves
- Eye protection (goggles or face shield)
- *Where possible where full face shield to maintain conservation of masks*

### GA

- Airborne droplet contact
  - *Where possible where full face shield to maintain conservation of masks*
  - *For COVID cases please remove N95 to reprocessing bin following case unless anticipating multiple COVID cases that shift.*

**Used/non-soiled N95 bins – please drop masks, where appropriate, in these bins! This is a critical process for a long term strategy for reprocessing. Masks can be reprocessed multiple times if not soiled, wet, or damaged. Also remember to consider a face shield!!**

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
