

**CODE PINK – SUSPECT OR CONFIRMED COVID**

**CODE TEAM:** ED Physician and/or PAEDIATRICIAN, W&C RN, and RT – 1<sup>st</sup> physician takes leads and if appropriate hands off care to paediatrician  
**PROTECTED PPE (AIRBORNE PRECAUTION):** N95 Mask, Face Shield, yellow gown, gloves, neck cover and bonnet

**1<sup>st</sup> RESPONDER:**

- Call for help/ initiate code blue (5555)
- Leave Room and Don PPE (AIRBORNE)

**ADDITIONAL RESPONDER(S):**

- Don PPE (AIRBORNE)
- Transport patient to the most appropriate space (negative pressure room when able)
- Brings Broselow Cart

**Patient has NO pulse and/or is NOT Breathing:**

- 2-person BVM is initiated – priority is to maintain tight mask seal
- Place board under patient (if required)
- Start chest compressions (if required)
- Attempt to apply multi-purpose PADS on patient's chest
- Await Code team to arrive

**Patient is breathing:**

- Place FILTERED Non-Rebreather Mask on patient (pull mask strap tight) set O2 at 15lpm
- Await Code team to arrive

**Code Team arrives:**

- Dons PPE (AIRBORNE)
- Code Team Physician takes lead
- If patient requires intubation
  - o Assess if able to transport patient to negative pressure room - 309
  - o If not able to transport, proceed to protective intubation steps

**Code Team arrives:**

- Dons PPE (AIRBORNE)
- Code Team Physician takes lead
- Preparation for protective intubation
