MNCYN Core Deliverables for Perinatal and Paediatric Programs

- Annual patient case reviews and education, led by MNCYN physician leads and education consultants
- Critical event reviews – unlimited
- Consultation with perinatal/paediatric education consultants - unlimited
- Education workshops, can include low fidelity workshops and webinar training with experts on specific topic for skill development in the region
- Online training programs – Regional Paediatric Orientation program (RPO) and Regional Maternal Newborn Orientation Program (RMNOP), various educational videos to support practice specific training
- Best practice program survey – every five (5) years
- Access to annual conference
- Dissemination and support for best practice standards and toolkits as rolled out by Ministry of Health or PCMCH
- Access to the Paediatric Monthly Review- an up-to-date educational document for best practices
- Access to MNCYN website with many tools to support best practice
- Participation at Regional Nurse Leaders meeting – spring and fall
- Regional Steering Committee member
- Connection to other like organizations for the purposes of sharing documentation and policies
- Connections between Public Health and acute care organizations for the purposes of sharing of resources and supporting transitions of care between hospital and home
